At a Special Meeting of the District Judges held on Thursday, January 6, 2011, the Judges met to consider the distribution of the docket of Judge Kathleen M. O'Malley, who has been appointed to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, but has been designated by the Federal Circuit for limited service on this Court through December 31, 2011.

After full deliberation, the Court determined that Judge O'Malley's civil docket would be distributed as follows:

1. Civil and MDL Cases


The cases on Judge O'Malley's docket which have been identified for transfer, shall be reassigned equally among the active district judges in the Eastern Division.

As to those cases that Judge O'Malley has indicated she is prepared to keep for final or partial resolution, she will work on those cases for a period of sixty (60) days, until March 7, 2011, and shall report to the Court on the status of those cases by March 1, so that further decisions can be made regarding the continued handling of any then-pending cases.

2. Death Penalty Cases

The Chief Judge shall review the three death penalty cases assigned to Judge O'Malley and the Court's protocol regarding the death penalty cases before making a recommendation to the Court regarding the assigning of those cases.
