
Pursuant to Administrative Order 2016-7, Thomas M. Parker has been selected as the new magistrate judge for the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Ohio and will be located in Cleveland, Ohio. Magistrate Judge Parker entered on duty March 25, 2016, and shall be placed on the civil, social security, and habeas corpus case draws on April 4, 2016, and the criminal draw on April 24, 2016. Magistrate Judge Parker will also participate with all the other eastern division magistrate judges in the Magistrate Judge Arraignment Protocol.

In order to establish a docket for the new magistrate judge, the reference of cases that had been referred to Magistrate Judge Greg A. White, whose retirement was effective on February 29, 2016, are hereby withdrawn and are referred to Magistrate Judge Parker. (List of referred cases needing reassignment attached.)

In addition, in order to facilitate the efficient and timely administration of justice, consent is withdrawn from cases remaining on Magistrate Judge White's consent docket and are returned to the previously assigned District Judge. The cases are hereby referred to Magistrate Judge Thomas M. Parker. If the parties wish to consent to the jurisdiction of Magistrate Judge Thomas M. Parker, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Section 636(c), they should complete and electronically file with the Clerk of Court a Consent to Exercise Jurisdiction by a United States Magistrate Judge form by Friday, April 8, 2016.
