This includes GED classes, Vocational/Educational Certificate Programs, Undergraduate and Graduate Studies.

During registration, you will talk to an EOC advisor and get help with:

- Career interest assessment & advising
- Educational planning
- Assistance with admission & financial aid applications (FAFSA)
- Career & education workshops
- College transfer assistance
- Assistance with enrollment in a One-Year Certificate Program
