CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 3
FILING PROCEDURES

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16, the Court conducted an initial scheduling and case management conference on July 2, 2024. Among other items discussed, the Court established the following filing procedures, and hereby AMENDS Section II.A. of Case Management Order No. 1 (Doc. No. 3, at 3) as follows:

1. For all documents other than motions for permission to appear *pro hac vice*, the following guidelines apply:

a. When filing a document that pertains to all cases, the phrase “ALL CASES” must appear in the caption immediately below the phrase “This Document Relates to.” The document should be filed only on the master docket.

b. When filing a document that pertains to fewer than all cases, the caption of the document must list the individual docket number(s) of the action(s) to which the document pertains on a separate line below the phrase “This Document Relates to.” The document should be filed on the docket of each individual action to which the document pertains, and not on the master docket. Additionally, counsel must file a notice of filing on the master docket indicating the following: (i) the title of the member-case filing; (ii) the

docket number(s) of the each individual action in which the document was filed; and (iii) the document number (i.e., ECF No. []) on each individual docket.


2. As to motions for permission to appear *pro hac vice*:

a. Attorneys representing parties in a case originating in the Northern District of Ohio must either be admitted to the Bar of the Northern District of Ohio or move for *pro hac vice* admission. This requirement is limited to attorneys representing parties in cases originating in this District because the trial for such cases will be held in the Northern District of Ohio. For all other attorneys, the admission requirement for this District is waived, provided the attorney is a member in good standing of the Bar of any court of the United States or of the highest court of any state.

b. Counsel moving for *pro hac vice* admission pursuant to the above paragraph need only do so on the master docket (so as to avoid being required to pay multiple fees). Additionally, such counsel must also file a notice of filing in each applicable individual member case, indicating that the motion was filed on the master docket pursuant to this Order and identifying the document number of such motion. Permission on the master docket to appear *pro hac vice* will apply to all member cases in which the attorney is counsel of record.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
