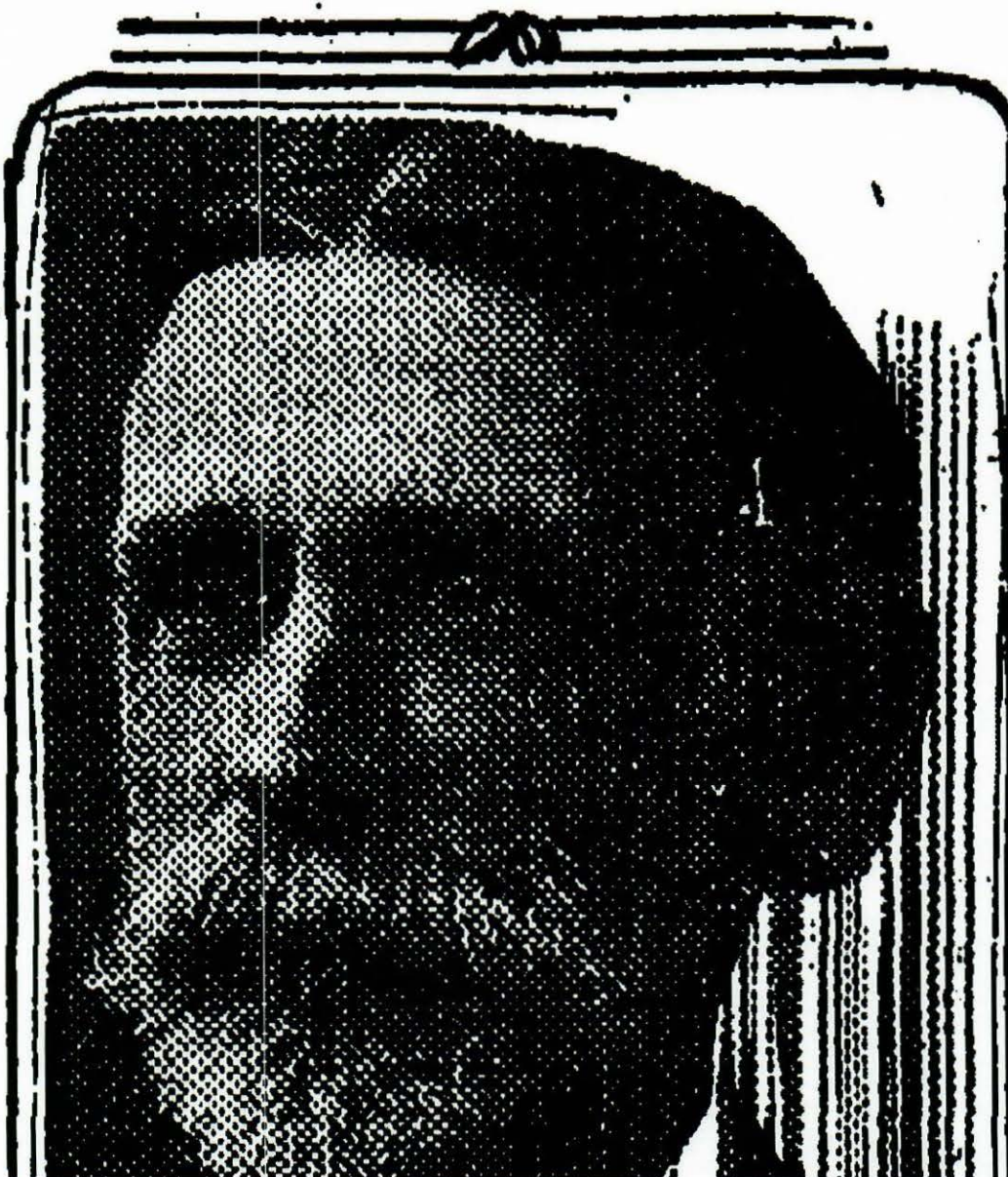

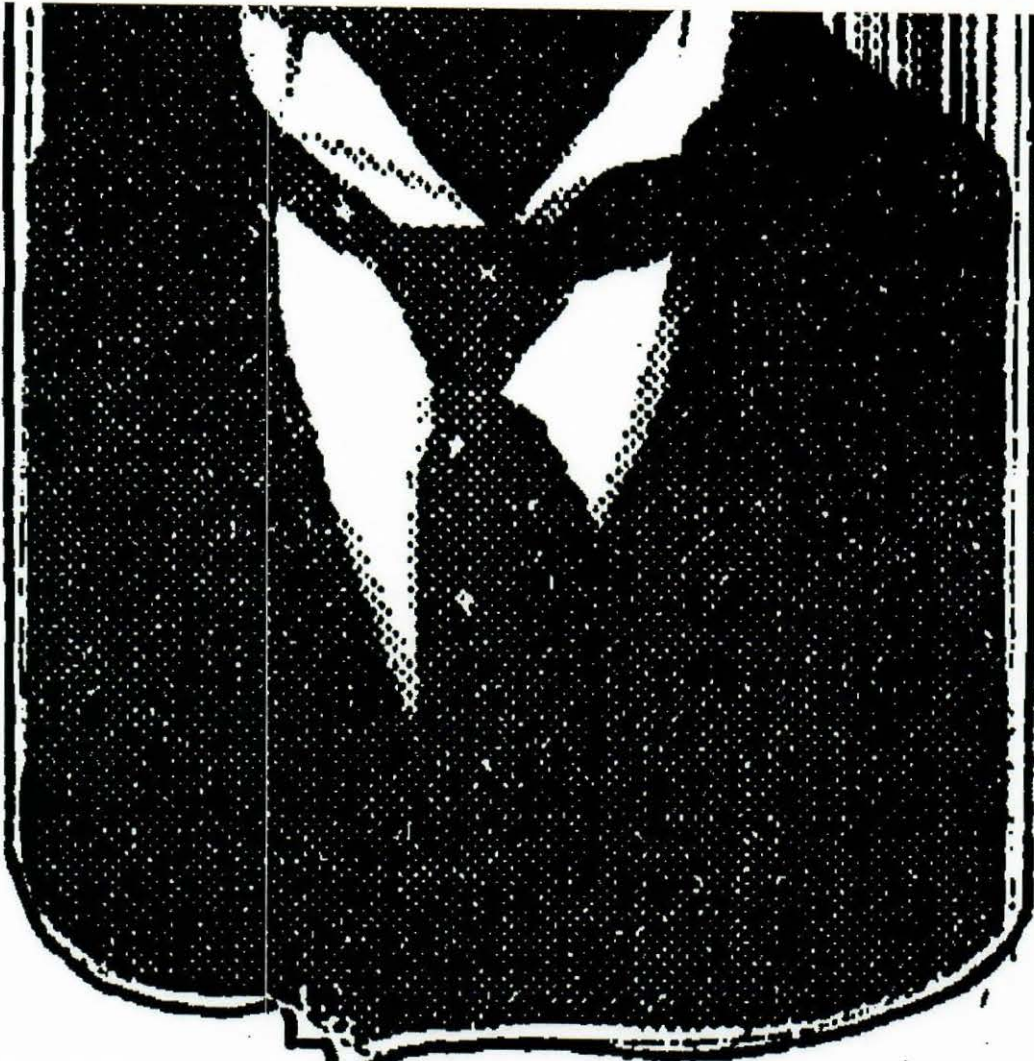

# **QUITS COURT POST AFTER LONG TERM**







**H. F. CARLETON.**

H. F. Carleton, for twenty-two years clerk of the United States district court, has resigned from office, the resignation to take effect Dec. 31. The court has appointed Mr. Carleton standing special master of the district court, master in chancery and special United States commis-  
sioner.

**SIORER.**

The resignation of the veteran clerk was given to the public on his sixty-ninth birthday. His successor in office is B. C. Miller, at present clerk of the circuit court. Inasmuch as the circuit court is ordered abolished by law on Dec. 31. Mr. Miller will become district court clerk.

Mr. Carleton has served under Judges Ricks, Wing, Taylor, Killits and Day. He was appointed clerk by Judge Ricks in 1890.
