Rule 4.1 Service of Actions Filed In Forma Pauperis

- (a) <u>Service</u>. Where a plaintiff has been granted leave to proceed <u>in form a pauperis</u>, the U.S. Marshal shall be directed to serve the summons and complaint, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(d) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c)(3), after the Court has first reviewed the complaint to determine whether <u>sua sponte</u> dismissal under section 1915(e)(2) is appropriate.
- **(b)** <u>Waiver of Service</u>. The provision for waiver of service in Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(d) shall not apply in cases filed by plaintiffs proceeding <u>in forma pauperis</u>. In all such cases, the U.S. Marshal shall serve the summons and complaint upon the Court's direction to do so.
