It appearing that the Federal Protective Service, Department of Homeland Security, has submitted a proposal for a revised forfeiture of collateral schedule for offenses committed in the Northern District of Ohio,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Sections 19 and 3401, Rule 58(d) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure and Local Criminal Rule 58.2(a), all previously entered orders regarding the forfeiture of collateral schedule for Federal Property Management and Motor Vehicle Violations promulgated under the authority of the Administrator of General Services or the Department of Homeland Security under Title 40, United States Code, Section 1315 (formerly, Section 318), are hereby VACATED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, unless the officer or inspector in his or her discretion requires a mandatory appearance, persons charged with violating an offense listed in the following forfeiture of collateral schedule for such Federal Property Management and Motor Vehicle violations may, in lieu of appearance, post collateral in the amount indicated for the offense and consent to the forfeiture of collateral.
