The Court hereby authorizes the disclosure to the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Ohio (FPD-OHN) and to the Office of the United States Attorney for the Northern District of Ohio of all sealed documents, presentence investigation reports, and sentencing orders and statements of reasons, including those portions of such orders not available through the Court's electronic filing system, for those inmates the FPD-OHN has identified as being potentially eligible for sentencing relief in light of the Supreme Court's interpretation of the Armed Career Criminal Act in *Johnson v. United States*, Case No. 13-7120 (June 26, 2015). Inmates whose cases the FPD-OHN will be accessing in light of this order are those individuals whose sentences United States Sentencing Commission personnel recently concluded were at least in part imposed pursuant to the career offender provisions of U.S.S.G. Ch. 4, Part B and/or under 18 U.S.C. § 924(c). The disclosure authorized by this order shall be for the sole purpose of enabling both offices identified above to make a preliminary assessment as to an inmate's potential eligibility for a sentence reduction under this new law.

This order shall remain in force until subsequent order of this Court or rulings in individual cases that obviate the need for this disclosure authorization.
