ORDER NO. 2019-04

Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act, Title 18, U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(I) and (c), the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Ohio is hereby appointed to represent those defendants who have been identified as being potentially eligible to seek a reduction of sentence, and to present any motions or applications for reduction of sentence, in accordance with Section 404 of the First Step Act of 2018.

In the event it is subsequently determined that private counsel or previously appointed CJA counsel should be appointed to represent a defendant, such counsel shall be appointed and the Federal Public Defender shall withdraw.

Should the Federal Public Defender determine that there is a prohibitive conflict in which the prospective client's interests are materially adverse to those of a current or former client with regard to representation of a defendant in the litigation, the Office of the Federal Public Defender shall notify the Court and request appointment of a member of the Criminal Justice Act Panel.
