PACER FEE EXEMPTION FOR ANDREW SCOTT LOGE ORDER NO. 2020-04

District Judge Dan Aaron Polster appointed Andrew Scott Loge as an additional staff member in the Multidistrict Litigation In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, Case No. 1:17-md-2804, and has requested a PACER fee exemption for Andrew Scott Loge (the "Applicant") in order to assist the Court.

Accordingly, the Applicant shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court to the extent such use is incurred in the course of conducting research for this Multidistrict Litigation matter. He shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court.

Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- 1. This fee exemption applies only to the Applicant and is valid only for the purposes stated above.
- 2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system.
- 3. By accepting this exemption, the Applicant agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption.
- 4. The Applicant is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet based databases.
- 5. This exemption is valid until the conclusion of this Multidistrict Litigation matter.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center, which should provide the Applicant a
