PACER FEE EXEMPTION FOR))	ORDER NO. 2022-12

Robert Hallam Tuck, a PhD research student at the Centre for Criminology at The University of Oxford Faculty of Law, has submitted a request for a PACER fee exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts. The applicant falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption on the basis that the applicant is performing academic research. Additionally, the applicant has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information.

Accordingly, the applicant shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching prisoner lawsuits filed in Criminal Alien Requirement (CAR) prisons, a subset of outsourced, all-foreign prison facilities established in 1999 by the Clinton Administration (these facilities are also frequently referred to as "contract prisons" by the Federal Bureau of Prisons). Specifically, Mr. Tuck's research project examines how men in CAR prisons understand, negotiate, and contest their confinement. The applicant shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court.

Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- 1. This fee exemption applies only to the applicant and is valid only for the purposes stated above.
- 2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system.
- 3. By accepting this exemption, the applicant agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption.
- 4. The applicant is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet based databases.
- 5. This exemption is valid until January 1, 2024.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time.
