Pharmaceuticals, Inc., 509 U.S. 579, must be filed two months before the standby trial date. A

party WAIVES the right to object to the qualifications of a testifying witness if the party

fails to file an objection by this date. Responses to such motions must be filed no later than 7

consecutive days after the motion is filed.
